Rules (FIFA Rules apply if not modified herein)

All players must be registered on their teams' official roster form before the tournament begins. Any team or player determined by the event director to have falsified age or skill level will be dismissed from the tournament. All players must be able to verify age. Rosters are final at kickoff of the team's first game.

Players

Eight is the maximum number of players on a team, four field players at one time. In Adult coed games, a minimum of two players must be female. Players may only play on one team per division. **There are no goalkeepers.**

Substitutions may occur on any dead ball, but players must get referee's attention before entering the field at the center line. All players must wear shinguards. Teams are responsible for providing appropriate sized games balls.

Field

The field shall be 40 yards by 30 yards and modified for younger age groups. The goal box, 8 feet wide by 10 feet long, is directly in front of the goal. No player may touch the ball within the goal box, however any player may move through the goal box. Any part of the ball or player's body on the line is considered in the goal box; the player is an extension of the box.

If a defender touches the ball in the goal box, a penalty kick is awarded to the offensive team. If an offensive player touches the ball within the goal box, a goal kick is awarded to the defensive team. If the ball comes to rest in the goal box, **regardless of which team it touches last, a goal kick** is awarded to the defensive team. The goals are 4ft x 8ft, and modified by age.

Game

The game shall consist of two 12 minutes halves with a two minute half-time, **or** the game shall end when a team scores 11 goals. No overtime, unless in a playoff.

Pool Play Games will be scored according to the following: 3 pts for a win, 1 pt for a tie and 0 pts for a loss.

Ties: In pool play, ties between 2 or more teams will use the following guidelines: head to head results between 2 tied teams; goal differential in pool play; fewest goals allowed in pool play; 4 player shootout.(all eligible players on roster)

Overtime: (Playoffs only) A three minute "golden goal" overtime. If score is still tied, the winner shall be decided by shoot out **with the 4 players on the field** at the end of the golden goal period.

A forfeited game shall be scored as 6-0

Play and Conduct

A goal may only be scored from a touch on the offensive half of the playing field. **No offsides** and **no slide tackling.**

In dead ball re-starts defending players must be at least 5 yards away from ball. If necessary, **the ball may be moved** to create the 5 yards. If an advantage cannot develop due to a defender delaying the quick re-start, the kick shall be retaken. Delaying the game shall not persist.

The ball shall be kicked into play from the side touch lines. All kicks from kick-ins, free-kicks and kick-offs may be taken in any direction and are **indirect** with the exception of corner kicks and penalty kicks. Goal-kicks may be taken from any point on the end line **but not** from the goal box.

Penalty kicks shall be awarded if, in the opinion of the referee, a scoring opportunity was nullified by an infraction. A penalty kick is a direct free kick taken from the center spot 12 yards from the goal with all players behind the midline. If a goal is not scored, **the defense is awarded a goal kick.** Penalty kicks are not live balls.

Referees and Conduct

Referees have the right to caution or eject a player for continual infringement of the rules or as a result of a single incident that warrants sending off.

Yellow Card - a 3 minute "rest" for the offending player.

Second Yellow card - the offending player can no longer play in that game (or if after the game, the following game), but team still plays with 4 players.

Red Card - Rest of the game plus the following game.

Team plays short for the remainder of the game (ie, only 3 field players) but may play with 4 players in the next game. Tournament Director may eject player for the rest of the tournament.

Sportsmanship and Fair Play

All players, coaches and spectators are expected to act in the spirit of good sportsmanship and fair play at all times. Abuse of the referees will not be tolerated. Any instance of such conduct will disqualify the responsible team from the event.

Situations not addressed within these rules shall be left to the sole discretion of the Tournament Director.
